Admission: \$6 Adults, \$4 Students. School faculty passes will be accepted.

Officials: Assigned by the Central Conference.

Home Team: For tournaments, the top team of the paired bracket shall be considered the HOME team, and shall wear white jerseys. This is defined as the team listed on the top line of the bracket, not necessarily the higher seeded team.

Team Bench: The HOME team will occupy the bench to the left side of the score table as you face the table. The VISITING team will occupy the bench to the right of the score table as you face it.

Seating/Supervision: Assigned seating for spectators will be posted. Each participating school must provide appropriate supervision for their students and fans. Supervisors shall identify themselves to the Tournament Director upon arrival.

Trainer: Seward High will have an athletic trainer on duty.

Artificial Noisemaker: NSAA guidelines prohibit the use of artificial noisemakers which would include horns, whistles, bells, etc...

Weather: In case of inclement weather, the Central Conference Executive Committee will notify the schools in the tournament and inform them of the revised schedule. Please send contact information to john.moody@sewardschools.org
