Ties: Team ties will be broken using the score of the 5th golfer. If a tie still exists, we

will count back starting with the number one handicap hole and using the total of all five golfers on each hole. Counting back on the scorecard in the same manner will break individual ties. Medalist honors will be decided by a sudden death playoff. If there is no 5th golfer, we will count back starting with the number one handicap hole and using the total of the four golfers counted in the team score.

RULES FOR FAIRBURY COUNTRY CLUB

HOLE 1 There is a penalty area (tall grass) marking the area on the right side of hole number 1. If you hit your ball into the area marked by the red stakes, play the ball as a penalty area or play it as it lies. This area is right off of the first tee (one stroke penalty).

There is also a **penalty area** in front of the green marked with yellow stakes. Drop with 1 stroke penalty in the drop area across the lake, near the big oak tree and in front of the green. The drop area is marked in white.

- **HOLE 2** Out of bounds to the right. Re-tee if your ball hits the telephone lines. **No Penalty** (local rule).
- **HOLE 3** Out of bounds to the right. Stroke and distance. **Do not trespass over the fence across the road to retrieve your ball.** If your ball comes to rest on the entrance road that crosses the fairway, you may drop at your nearest point of relief no closer to the hole without penalty. Take full relief from the road but no nearer the hole. There is also free relief from the flower bed by the FCC brick sign.
- **HOLE 4** Out of bounds right. Stroke and distance. **Do not trespass to retrieve your ball**. If the ball enters the lake to the left of the fairway, take a drop where the ball crossed into the **penalty area** with a **one-stroke penalty**. The net protecting 7 tee is played as an abnormal course condition. Take full relief and drop within one club length —**no penalty** no nearer the hole.
- **HOLE 5** Out of bounds right. Stroke and distance. **DO NOT trespass to retrieve your ball**. If your ball lands in the **penalty area** that runs in front of the green, <u>one-stroke penalty</u> and use the drop area on the south side of the creek. As the creek moves to the north, use the drop area across the creek and take a <u>one-stroke penalty</u>.
- **HOLE 6** The same creek that runs in front of hole 5 also runs in front of hole six. Use the drop area on the north side of the creek and take a <u>one stroke penalty</u>.
- **HOLE 7** There is out of bounds about 30 yards behind the green. It is marked with the fence line. Use the drop area and play the There is also an area with tall, over-grown grass to the west (left-side if facing the green) of the green. If your ball went into the grass, use the drop area. NO PENALTY.
- **HOLE 8** There are two penalty areas. One immediately to the left of the tee and another to the left over the hill approximately 200 yards out. Both are **penalty areas** that could come into play on the tee shot. The **penalty area** on hole #4 could come into play this hole if a ball is hit well left.
- **HOLE 9** Out of bounds left. Behind and to either side of the green are heavy trees. If your ball enters these trees and you find it, you may play it as it lies, or play it as a **penalty area** and use the drop areas and assess the <u>one-stroke</u> penalty.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: -If there is ever any uncertainty, play two balls and keep your score with both balls. A ruling will be made once you finish your round.
