

### Basketball Game Information Sheet

Teams: Beatrice Orangemen/Lady Orange vs. Crete  
Date: Thursday, Dec. 10, 2020  
Site: Beatrice High School, 600 Orange Boulevard

Time Schedule: 3:30pm - girls JV game in O Zone  
Immediately after girls JV game - Senior night presentation GBB  
To follow (approx.. 5:00pm) - girls V game in O Zone

Between these games, the building will be cleared to allow other fans to attend.

7:00pm - boys V game in O Zone  
Immediately after boys V game - Senior night presentation for cheer, BBB  
To follow (approx.. 8:30pm) - boys JV game in O Zone

After the first game, teams should plan to warm up in the Aux gym. Beatrice south end, Crete north end. Teams will only be allowed 5-10 minutes on the O Zone floor to warm up prior to their game while disinfecting occurs. This is intended to help teams and spectators exit the building as quickly as possible.

OT - If JV games are tied after regulation, the game will be declared a tie. Overtime will not be played for JV.

Admission prices: Adults...\$5 Students...\$4  
Faculty passes will be accepted for the visiting team (holder only)  
Trailblazer Conference passes will be accepted for conference games.  
Only those on the pass list will be admitted.

Gates open for the girls games at 3:00pm  
Gates open for the boys games at 6:30pm

Other considerations due to COVID-19:

Avoid the 3 C's: Crowded places, Close contact, Confined spaces

Student-athletes should arrive at contests already dressed for competition.

Participants, coaches, officials, and spectators must perform a self-screening prior to arriving at school sites or participating in NSAA activities. Symptomatic persons may not attend until visiting a healthcare provider, being given an alternate diagnosis, are fever-free for 24 hours and symptoms have improved OR until they have tested negative for COVID-19.

Masks must be worn at all times by all non-active participants (not currently in the game), and coaches, and spectators. Cheer and dance are considered non-active participants.

Face coverings must cover the nose and mouth.

(City of Beatrice passed a mask mandate on Nov. 17. It will be enforced by police.)

Spectator attendance will be reduced to 25% indoor capacity or less, and 6 feet of distance between household groups is required.

Only household members of participants (living in the same home) will be allowed to attend. Spectators must sit in seats not blocked off by yellow tape.

Green dot = okay to sit there

Red dot = do not sit there

Up to 4 spectators per Beatrice HS player.

Up to 2 spectators per cheerleader, dance team member, visiting player & Coach

All spectators must be on a list provided to BHS administration prior to the contest.

Only the official scorer, clock operator, and announcer are permitted to be seated at the score table.

Team members will spread out from each other as much as possible while on the bench.

Live video broadcasts will be provided as often as possible ([striv.tv/beatrice](http://striv.tv/beatrice))

Spectators should arrive just before start time and leave immediately after contests.

Enter main doors. Exit west Hevelone doors. (see map)

Visiting schools/communities will have separate seating sections in bleachers, and are expected to use assigned restrooms and concession stand areas.

Beatrice fans are assigned the entire west bleachers, and the south half of the east bleachers. Beatrice fans are assigned the restrooms between the O Zone and Aux Gym. Beatrice fans will utilize the north side of the concession stand. Visiting fans are assigned the north half of the east bleachers, and the restrooms east of the gym. Visiting fans will utilize the south side of the concession stand.

No visiting cheerleaders are permitted. Beatrice cheerleaders will occupy the south end line. Beatrice dance team members will occupy the north end line.
