Basketball Events:

Teams:

- *Visiting teams will be encouraged to take temps prior to leaving home; however if this doesn't take place, we will ask your team to check team personnel temperatures when they arrive at our facilities. Minden athletes and coaches will have their temps taken and documented before leaving Minden; this document will be shared with your school personnel upon arrival.*
- Visiting teams will enter the front doors of the building and be assigned a locker room, shower, and restroom all within the same locker space.
- Home team will be assigned a locker room, shower, and restroom within the same locker space.
- During a basketball contest; teams will be assigned a bench area. They will remain in this bench area for the entire contest. Bench areas will be sanitized after the game is complete (when applicable) - if a new team was going to occupy this area.
- Athletes in competition do not need to wear a mask..
- Each team will have the first row of bleachers behind their bench for players not participating.
- We have water bottle filling stations up and downstairs in the high school and in multiple places in our middle school. I will supply team water coolers next to your bench.
- Players should not enter the stands to visit and greet fans prior to or after games.
- Coaches, scorer table, gate workers, and administration will be masked.
- Scorer table will be occupied by a clock operator, bookkeeper, and announcer. Visiting team bookkeepers will need to operate in the 1st/2nd row of bleachers or a chair on the team bench.

Fans:

- **Fans entering the facility will be required to wear a mask and social distance.**
- Home team fans will be directed to the bleachers on the North side of the HS gym and East side of the bleachers in the MS gym.
- Visiting team fans will be directed to the bleachers on the South side of the HS gym or the West bleachers in the MS gym.
- Fans/patrons/parents should not enter the gym floor before, during, or after the game.
- The first row of bleachers should not be used on the visitor side of the high school and middle school gyms unless needed for handicap seating.
- Home cheerleaders will be on the Northwest end of the gym. Visiting cheerleaders will be on the Southeast end of the gym. Cheerleaders should stay in that area and not come close to the sport huddle or in front of the stands..
- We are going to have a concession stand; workers will wear masks and gloves to serve. Anyone wishing to purchase something from the concession stand will need to wear a mask.
- Once a spectator purchases their food or drink item, they may sit in the cafeteria or return to their seat and eat/drink the item. They may do so unmasked, but once the food/drink is consumed, then the mask needs to be put on.
- Hand sanitizer should be at the concessions area, benches, gate, and scorer table.
- Children through 5th grade will need to be accompanied by a parent or guardian and must sit with them at these contests.

Minden Public School Guidelines for Basketball Events

Fans:

- **Fans entering the facility will be required to wear a mask and social distance.**

- We are going to have a concession stand; workers will wear masks and gloves to serve. Anyone wishing to purchase something from the concession stand will need to wear a mask.
