Event/Location:

Seward/Crete/Milford triangular volleyball matches at Seward High School, October 12 and 13, 2020.

Parking:

Busses and spectators may park in the South or East lot.

Admission:

Pregame:

Fan seating:

Seward- North section, Crete-Northwest section, Milford- Middle section of the South side (teams will occupy the outside sections).

**COVID PROTOCOLS:**

-Please bring your own balls for warm-ups.

-No towels or water will be provided for team bench area. Athletes need to bring their own water bottle, Seward does have safe water refilling stations.

-No locker rooms are available; no showers are available.

-Teams will remain at the same bench throughout the evening, except Milford will change between match 2 and 3. Benches will be sanitized between.

- Face coverings are required to gain admission into the event and must be worn by non-participants at all times. Coaches and team bench personnel should wear face coverings unless social distancing is practiced.
- Face coverings are optional for game participants.
- Visiting score keeper will remain with or behind the visiting bench.
- Only individually wrapped outside food is allowed for teams at Seward High School, no family or buffet style meals or coolers allowed.
- We ask that spectators leave promptly after the conclusion of the contest.
